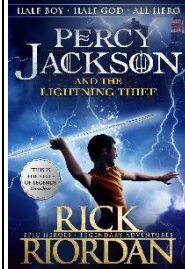
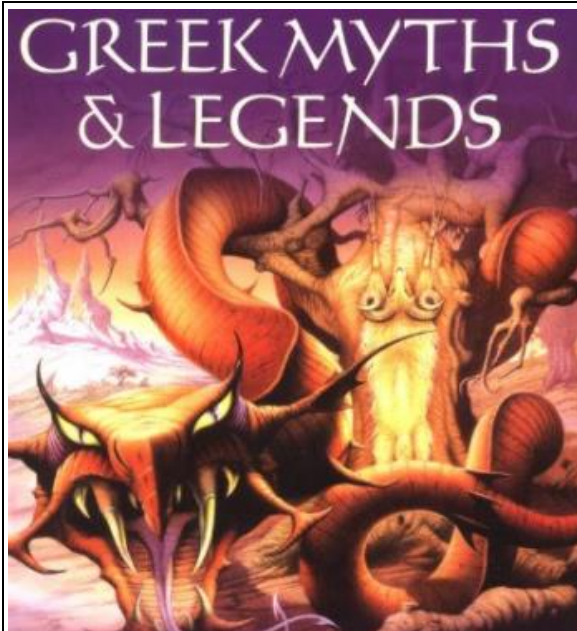


Year 5 Autumn 1 – Myths and Legends
